

1. Beach in a Tub



What do I need?

Plastic sea animals, a small tub and shells/rocks to decorate. A spray bottle and scooper are also fun.

What will my child learn?

Vocabulary & imagination



Firstly, let your child get out all the sea animals. Name them as you go. Talk about the ones that are new and repeat the names again.

*Octopus starfish sting ray whale seal
shark*

Parent Tips

New words are learnt through repetition and practice.

You don't need to ask 'What's that?' Just keeping naming the animals.

🦆 Place all the animals in the tub and add rocks, shells, sand or other decorations for your own Beach in a Tub. Add water!

“Put the shark over here.”

“This starfish can go on the bottom.”



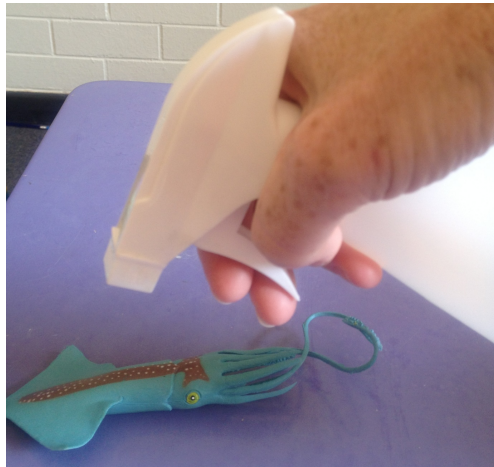
🦆 Talking about the creatures and playing with them are the best way for your child to learn lots of new words. Attention and enjoyment are pre-requisites for learning.

🦆 If playing inside, you can spray the animals with a spray bottle. (instead of using a tub of water).

As you spray the creatures, repeat the names so that your child can learn any new names.

“The squid is wet!”

“Spray the starfish.”



🦆 You can scoop the creatures out with a large spoon, tongs or net too!
